
Q16 What is the average number of students registered in/attending social security related courses?


Q17 How many academics are involved in teaching social security related topics in your institution? Please mention their number per area








Q23 Is the streaming platform linked to the Learning platform?




Q24 Does your Learning platform have a SCORM player?




Q48 Does the University provide access to an audio studio/room to record narration/voice overs?




Q63 In your opinion, would the development of a joint curriculum in social security be a welcome development?







Q64 In your opinion, what form should this joint curriculum take? (multiple responses are possible)






