

Product IO5: Course catalogue
(EFESE depository app)

Introduction

The depository app, which fulfils the need for a course exchange platform under IO2, is also used in the context of some of the ambitions of IO5. In the first place, it serves as a catalogue of the available courses which can be incorporated in the curriculum. Furthermore, the mandatory approval of submitted courses by the coordinator guarantees the uniformity of the courses, and makes the screening of their academic quality possible. Besides 'collecting' material, this approach allows us to 'select' the courses that fit well into the planned curriculum and approach the relevant authors. Last but not least, the exchange initiative, which is facilitated by the depository app, could provide incentives for other academic institutions to join and submit their own courses. This enlarges the pool of courses available for implementation into the common curriculum.
